NEW SHADE SAIL FOR THE PLAYGROUND

It gives me great pleasure to inform you that another successful capital project was completed at Alexander School this week. Thanks to the generous support of **Mr & Mrs Hovig and Rita Tchetchenian**, we were able to install a new shade structure over a large section of the playground. The structure provides the required shade over targeted areas of the playground, in particular the sand pit. Ever since the removal of the dangerous gum trees from the centre of the playground, the sand pit area had lost the shade that the trees provided when it was first installed. As a result, the students who spent their lunchtime playing there were exposed to the dangerous rays of the sun, and the need to provide a cover had become a priority.

Towards the end of last year, Mr Tchetchenian visited Alexander school to drop off a number of books for the Library. During the visit, as one of our Founding Members, we were having a general discussion about the life of the school and the future plans. While outside, our discussion was centred around the new junior playground and the removal of the gum trees. Mr Tchetchenian then questioned what we were intending to do with the area and I explained that the plan was to install some kind of cover, to provide sun protection.



With no hesitation, he suggested if we would be interested in having one of his friends in this trade to come over and provide a quote. I was happy with the suggestion, as it would help initiate the project. However, it was his follow up comment that caught me by complete surprise, as he said: *"I want them to send the quote to me, as I like to cover the cost of the project"*. I was lost for words, because even before we both had any idea of what the anticipated cost would be, we had a sponsor who was willing to support the school at any cost.

As a result, thanks to the professional services of 'Alfresco Shade', the \$11,000 project was finalised, to support the students and community of Alexander school.

The project had an initial completion date before our Easter Concert, but the current environment had delayed the process. Therefore, it was an honour to have Mr & Mrs Hovig and Rita Tchetchenian at the school to witness the final stage of the construction, when the shade sail cloth was put in place. They were joined by his parents Mr & Mrs Varoujan and Sonia Tchetchenian, who are also school benefactors.

On behalf of the School Board and the Alexander community, I would like to once again thank them for their ongoing support and wish them and their families all of God's blessings.

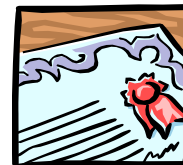
